

Revised Mechanics of the Team Competition of the SND's Cup

- The Team competition is open to all AFP Branches of Service/Units, PNP Units, Law Enforcement Agencies, and Government Agencies.
- There shall be a five (5) members per Team with all scores to count. All Team Members should be bona fide regular personnel of the AFP Branch of Service/Unit, PNP unit, Law Enforcement Agency, and/or Government Agency.
- AFP Branches of Service/Units, PNP Units, Law Enforcement Agencies, and Government Agencies may field more than one (1) shooting team in every Division:
 - **Stock Hi-Cap** (Standard)
 - **Double Action/Striker Fired** (Production)
 - **Single Stack** (.40 or .45 cal with only 8 rounds in magazines)
- The **Total Individual Match Points** of each of the five (5) team members will be added to get the **Total Team Match Points per Division** which will be the basis to determine the **Team winners per Division**.
- The **Overall Team Champion** award shall be given to the AFP Branch of Service/Unit, PNP unit, Law Enforcement Agency, and/or Government Agency that will have the highest **combined** Total Team Match Points of their **highest scoring Stock Hi-Cap (Standard) Team, highest scoring Double Action/Striker Fired(Production) Team, and highest scoring Single Stack Team**.
- A shooter may participate in only one shooting team.
- In case a member of a shooting team will be disqualified from the match due to safety reasons or violation of the Rules, his/her scores will be zero for the Team competition.
- There will be no Team fee. The individual shooters, who are members of the team, will just pay their individual match fees of P1,000 per shooter.
- A copy of the Proof of Payment (Bank Deposit Slip) must be e-mailed to *psmoc.main@gmail.com* together with the filled-up and signed registration form, list of the team members in the respective Divisions with their firearm details, and preferred squad number/date of shoot for pre-registration.
- Pre-registered Shooters/Teams should proceed to their first stage to pick-up their scoresheets and shooter's cards.
- Team composition is considered final three days before the start of the match.
- To avoid delays and for the organized conduct of the match, all shooters/teams are urged to pre-register.
