

Mechanics for 4th PSA Challenge

- The competition is open to all Registered Private Security Personnel (PSP) such as SG, SO and others with valid License to Exercise Security Profession (LESP) and Private Security Service Provider (PSSP), such as PSAs, PDAs, CGFs and other Accredited Private Security Services with valid License to Operate (LTO)/Accreditation.
- It shall be a Five-Man-Shooting-Team consisting of five (5) Security Guards/Lady Guards/Protection Agent or mix with All-Score-To-Count Scheme. However, a Security Officer is encouraged to accompany their shooting team in the venue to supervise.
- PSSPs may field more than one (1) shooting team composed of another PSP. However, Individual PSP may shoot individually provided that he/she will re-register as individual shooter.
- PSSP with the HIGHEST SCORING TEAM ENTRY (*total member match points of a team*) will be declared as Champion and will receive the Trophy.
- All participating PSP as shooter should be in SOSIA prescribed Security Guard/Officer or Protection Agent uniform while shooting the courses of fire.
- Registration form must be accompanied by photocopy of valid LESP and Duty Detail Order (DDO) from PSSP.
- Original Proof of Payment (Deposit Slip/Acknowledgement Receipt) must be emailed to csg.gunclub36@gmail.com together with filled-out and signed registration form, list of the team members and preferred squad number/date of shoot for pre-registration.
- Pre-registered Shooters/Teams should present proof of payment and identity at the Registration Desk. If confirmed by registration, then claim the Shooter's Card/s.
- Team composition is considered final on the deadline of pre-registration one (1) week before this event. Any changes of team composition is subject to appeal to the Organizing Committee thru the Match Administrator.
- PSSPs is encourage to bring their own firearms, such as: Shotgun with shoulder stock and no pistol grip, Pistol (9mm) and Revolver (.38). However, there will be available house guns at the range.
- To avoid delays and for the organized conduct of the match, all shooters are urged to pre-register.
